SECTION 1. That the area described as follows is hereby designated a I2 (General Industrial) District under the terms of Chapter 157 Title XV of the Code of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana:

A PART OF THE NORTH WEST ¼ OF THE SOUTH WEST ¼ OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 12 EAST AS FO1LOWS, BEGINNING AT THE WEST ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 12 EAST RUNNING ALONG THE¼ LINE OF SAID SECTION 12 - 766 CHAINS TO A STONE; THENCE SOUTH 11-60 CHAINS TO A STONE; THENCE WEST 12.86 CHAINS TO A STONE; ON THE WEST 1INE OF SAID SECTION; THENCE NORTH 11.57 CHAINS ALONG THE WEST 1INE OF SAID SECTION TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING. THE ABOVE DESCRIBED TRACT TO CONTAIN 14.84 ACRES. EXCEPT THAT PART THEREOF CONVEYED FOR RIGHT OF WAY PURPOSES IN DOCUMENT NUMBER 70-05322.

PROJECT SUMMARY

• The property consists of a single-family home surrounded by an ag field on 14.84 acres.

The petitioner requested a rezoning from R1/Single Family Residential to I2/General Industrial and approval of a primary development plan for a proposed 100,000 square foot building intended for machining, metal fabrication, and warehousing. The project is located on the southeast corner of the intersection of Ardmore and Nuttman Avenue. The immediate properties are zoned residential in every direction. A broader view the area shows a significant amount of industrial zoning and development. The properties north and west of the site have floodplain and are developed as sports fields and vegetable farming.

The site plan includes one proposed 100,000 square foot industrial building near the southeast corner of the site. The plan includes wide drives for semi-truck traffic as well as 50 parking spaces on the north side of the building. Landscaping is proposed throughout the site that appear to meet all zoning ordinance standards. Detention is located on the northwest corner of the site. Access is shown off Nuttman and Ardmore Avenue as well as improvements to the intersection. The applicant has not requested any waivers and will meet all zoning ordinance requirements.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN REVIEW

Future Growth and Development Map, Goals, and Strategies

- The project site is located within the Urban Infill Area. Municipal infill areas benefit from existing infrastructure and adjacency to other community amenities. These second-tier infill areas are a focus for reinvestment and for filling in gaps within established neighborhoods. Development in urban infill areas should be focused on vacant lots within neighborhoods and commercial or industrial areas already served by infrastructure.
- The following Goal would be applicable and supportive of this request:
 LUD1. Encourage compatible infill development and redevelopment in the Urban Infill and Priority Investment Areas

Pat Hess, representing the applicant, presented the request as outlined above. Based on comments from staff and the public, the applicant has agreed to a Written Commitment to enhance landscaping along the northern portion of the project, adjacent to the McNeal farm. Mr. Hess stated that the

majority of truck traffic will use Ardmore Avenue, and storage would be on the rear of the building, and this is a first shift operation.

Public Comments:

Joshua and Lindsey McNeal, Nuttman Avenue – Feel the proposal does not meet the comprehensive plan. They are concerned about property values, quality of life and how this will affect their business.

John Haifley, Ardmore Avenue – Submitted a letter of support.

The Plan Commission recommends that Rezoning Petition REZ-2023-0044 be returned to Council, with a "Do Pass" recommendation and a Written Commitment, after considering the following:

- 1. Approval of the rezoning request will be in substantial compliance with the City of Fort Wayne Comprehensive Plan, and should not establish an undesirable precedent in the area. The I2/General Industrial zoning will provide the opportunity to redevelop the site while providing additional industrial options along Ardmore Road.
- 2. Approval of the request will not have an adverse impact on the current conditions in the area, or the character of current structures and uses in the area. The property is near industrial zoning and uses further to the east and south. The proposal would construct an entirely new structure. Ardmore is considered one of the busiest industrial thoroughfares within Fort Wayne.
- 3. Approval is consistent with the preservation of property values in the area. This proposal will allow reinvestment into the area and is near I2/General Industrial property to the east and south. The new zoning gives the property owner flexibility to invest in the property industrially.
- 4. Approval is consistent with responsible development and growth principles based on existing uses and infrastructure in the area. Review by City engineering departments will ensure the required infrastructure is provided to the site. The rezoning is consistent with existing I2/General Industrial zoning near the property to the east and south.

These findings approved by the Fort Wayne Plan Commission on September 18, 2023.

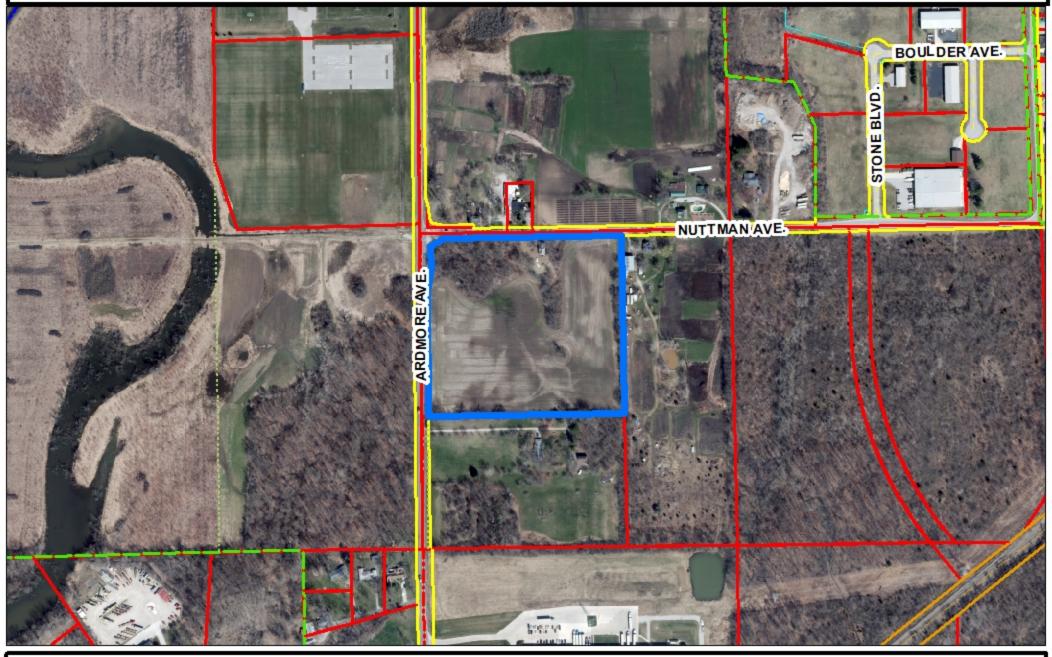

Jacob:

Attached is a revised site plan that incorporates enhanced landscaping in the area between the detention basin on the west and the proposed Nuttman Ave driveway entrance on the east. My client believes this will go a long way to allaying the concerns of the neighbor to the north about having to see a building across the street. My client will be willing to put this into a written commitment. A couple of other points:

- 1. ERI reduced the size of the detention basin. As you know, primary development plans are to show the general scheme of development. Nothing is engineered to the tenth of a foot, but the first plan probably showed a bigger detention area than was needed. This may very well allow my client to save existing trees in the detention area. Unfortunately, the trees and the detention area occupy the same low spot. This is probably why this corner was never farmed and trees were allowed to grow instead of being clear cut to allow for crops as was done on the rest of the property.
- 2. The enhanced landscaping to the north of the site includes evergreen trees to provide year-round screening.
- 3. I should have noted at the public hearing that all of the loading and unloading will occur on the south side of the building, away from the neighbors to the north.
- 4. The building is planned to be approximately 30 feet high. The max. in I2 is 50 feet. The max. in R1 the existing district is 40 feet.
- 5. So much was discussed about AR zoning at the hearing that I think it was lost that the actual zoning of the property is R1 and not AR. As R1 with sewer and water available, these 14 acres could be developed into single family, with no screening, and no requirement or expectation that the existing treed would be saved. In fact, the detention basin would likely be larger with all the streets that would be necessary for a subdivision, thus jeopardizing more existing trees.
- 6. Finally, and while this is a bit indelicate, it should be noted that the existing owner could have harvested the trees at any time in the last 50 years, and nothing could have been said. We are glad they didn't. Murray Equipment will do its best to be good stewards of the land, and good neighbors.

DRAFT WRITTEN COMMITMENT

[Cross reference to: Doc. No. 76-32244]

This Written Commitment ("Commitment"), dated as of the date recorded on the signature page, is made by the Estate of Garrett E. Lloyd ("Owner") and Murray Property Management, LLC, an Indiana limited liability company ("Developer").

RECITALS

- A. By virtue of that certain Warranty Deed dated December 16, 1976, and recorded on December 22, 1976, as Document Number 76-32244, in the Office of the Recorder of Allen County, Indiana, Owner is the owner in fee simple of certain real estate located in Allen County, Indiana, which is legally described in Exhibit "A" attached to this Commitment ("Real Estate").
- B. Murray Property Management, LLC, an Indiana limited liability company ("Developer") is under contract with Owner to purchase the Real Estate and develop it into an industrial facility for operations maintained by Murray Equipment, Inc, an Indiana corporation.
- C. Owner and Developer petitioned the Fort Wayne Plan Commission (the "Commission") for approval of Rezoning Petition REZ 2023-0044 (the "Rezoning") to rezone the Real Estate from R1 Single Family Residential to I2 General Industrial. Simultaneously, Developer applied to the Commission for approval of Primary Development Plan PDP-2023-0034 (the "Primary Development Plan") to allow an industrial facility to be constructed on the Real Estate.
- D. On September 24, 2023, 2023, the Commission recommended approval of the Rezoning to the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne ("Council"), and conditionally approved the Development Plan.
- E. On ______, 2023, the Council approved the Rezoning, subject to this Written Commitment.
- F. As part of the Commission's conditional approval of the Primary Development Plan, the Commission required and or accepted this Commitment concerning the use and development of the Real Estate, and further, Owner consent and agree to the terms and restrictions contained in this Commitment.
- G. Pursuant to IC 36-7-4-1015, the Commission and Council may accept or require an owner of real property to make a written commitment concerning the use or development of property as a part of a rezoning or development plan.

COMMITMENT

Owner and Developer agree and consent to the following written commitments which shall govern the Real Estate:

- 1. **STATEMENT OF COMMITMENTS.** The Owner and Developer shall abide by the following commitments:
 - 1.1. **Enhanced screening:** The Owner and Developer commit to installing additional landscape screening along the north property line of the Real Estate, from the proposed detention area eastward to the proposed entrance to the Real Estate off Nuttman Avenue, as depicted on the Primary Development Plan attached as Exhibit B to this Commitment
 - 1.2. **Alternative Storm Detention.** The Owner and Developer commit to investigating whether a bio swale could be used along the frontage of Nuttman and Ardmore Avenues instead of the dry detention basin as shown on the Primary Development Plan, subject to the review and approval of staff and other reviewing agencies as a part of the site plan routing review.
 - 2. BINDING EFFECT, MODIFICATION, TERMINATION. This Commitment shall run with the Real Estate, and shall be binding upon Owner and Developer, each subsequent owner and developer of the Real Estate and upon each other person acquiring an interest in the Real Estate (including a leasehold interest), unless this Commitment is modified or terminated. The Recitals are incorporated by reference and are expressly made a part of this Commitment. This Commitment may be modified or terminated only by a decision of the Commission following a public hearing held by the Commission wherein notice has been given as provided by the Commission's rules of procedure. The Plan Commission shall have the discretion whether to approve or deny any proposed modification or termination of this Commitment.
 - 3. *RECORDING*. Owner or Developer shall, at their own expense, record this Commitment with the Allen County Recorder and shall provide two copies of the recorded Commitment to the Zoning Administrator.
 - 4. **ENFORCEMENT RIGHTS.** Any violation of this Commitment shall be deemed a violation of the zoning ordinance in effect at the time of the violation; provided, however, that nothing in this Commitment shall be construed as giving any person the right to compel enforcement of it by the Plan Commission or any enforcement official designated in the zoning ordinance, or any successor agency having zoning jurisdiction over the Real Estate. Pursuant to I.C. §36-7-4-1015, the Plan Commission or any enforcement official designated in the zoning ordinance, shall be entitled to all legal and equitable remedies available, including specific performance and injunctive relief, for any violation of this Commitment. The enforcement rights of the Plan Commission or any enforcement official designated in the zoning ordinance are cumulative, not exclusive.
 - 5. **GOVERNING LAW.** This Commitment, including the restrictions and covenants hereunder, shall be governed by the laws of the State of Indiana.
 - 6. **SEVERABILITY**. Each covenant or restriction contained in any paragraph of this

Commitment shall be severable and separate, and if any court shall rule that any particular restriction or covenant is unenforceable, such ruling shall not affect the enforceability of any other restriction or covenant under this Commitment, and such other restriction or covenant shall be enforced.

- 7. *EFFECTIVE DATE*. This Commitment shall be effective upon the following events, whichever occurs last:
 - 7.1. The Commission's approval of the Development Plan when same shall become a final and non-appealable zoning decision;
 - 7.2. The Council's approval of the Rezoning; and
 - 7.3. The recording of this Commitment in the Office of the Recorder of Allen County, Indiana.
- 8. *STATUTORY AUTHORITY*. This Commitment is made pursuant to IC 36-7-4-1015.

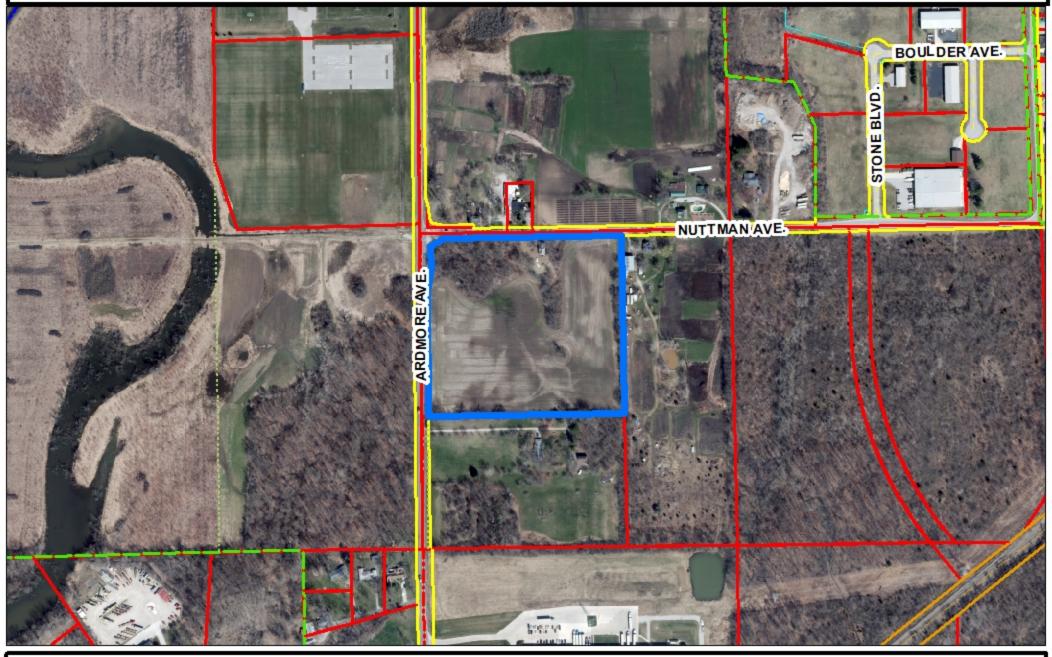

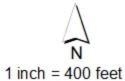






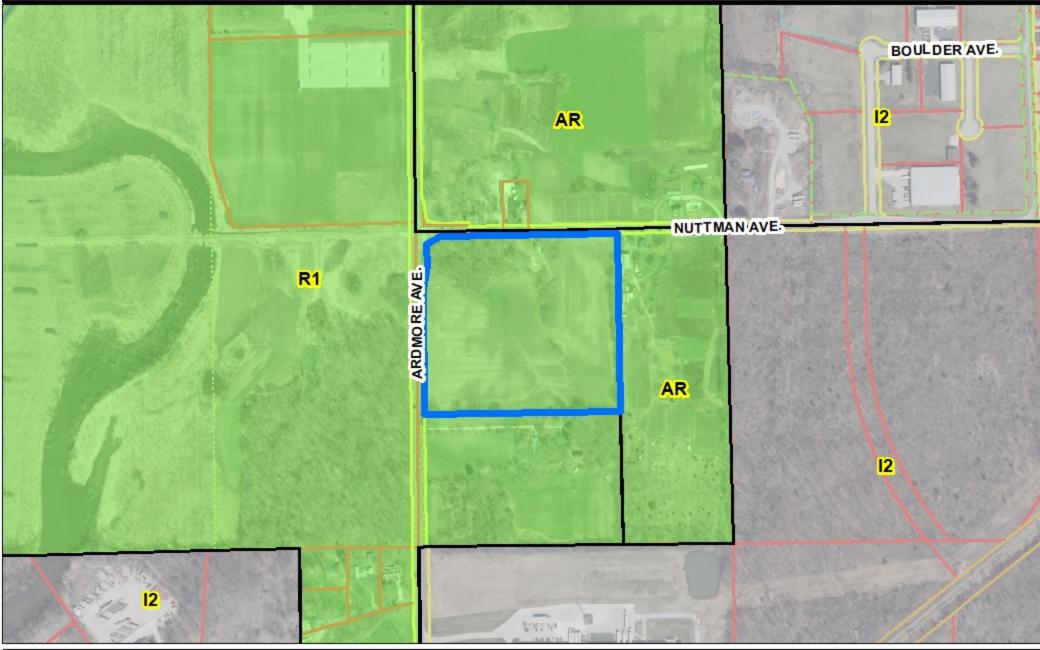

Rezoning Criteria:

1. The Comprehensive Plan

The current comprehensive plan for Fort Wayne, *All In Allen: Moving Forward Together*, effective March 13, 2023 (the "Comprehensive Plan"), incorporates the policy of adjacent growth expressed in the two previous Comprehensive Plans for the jurisdiction. The subject parcel is 530 feet north of and 450 feet west of a large area currently zoned I2. Additionally, ¾ of Section 16 of Wayne Township (120 out of a total of 160 acres) where this property is located is zoned I2. The subject property is within the Urban Infill Area noted on the Future Growth and Development Map in the Comprehensive Plan (p. 53). Finally, the subject parcel is served by public sewer and water infrastructure is available, further supporting the policy of sustainable growth in area where such services are available.

2. Current conditions and the character of current structures and uses in the district

The overriding character of this area is a mixture of agricultural, residential and industrial zoning and uses, along with recreational uses to the west. The proposed zoning and use are in keeping with that character. The proposal does not seek to create a new "footprint" of industrial zoning in an area where little or no industrial zoning exists.

3. The most desirable use for which the land in the district is adapted

The area within a half mile radius of the intersection of Nuttman and Ardmore avenues features considerable industrial zoning and uses. For example, there are the Stonewall and Engle Ridge Industrial parks to the south, and various industrial developments along Freeman Street north of Nuttman Avenue, east of this site. The subject property is within a corridor of industrial zoning that projects southwest from Fort Wayne along the railroad lines to the Fort Wayne International Airport. Existing development patterns show that industrial uses are desirable on and around the subject property.

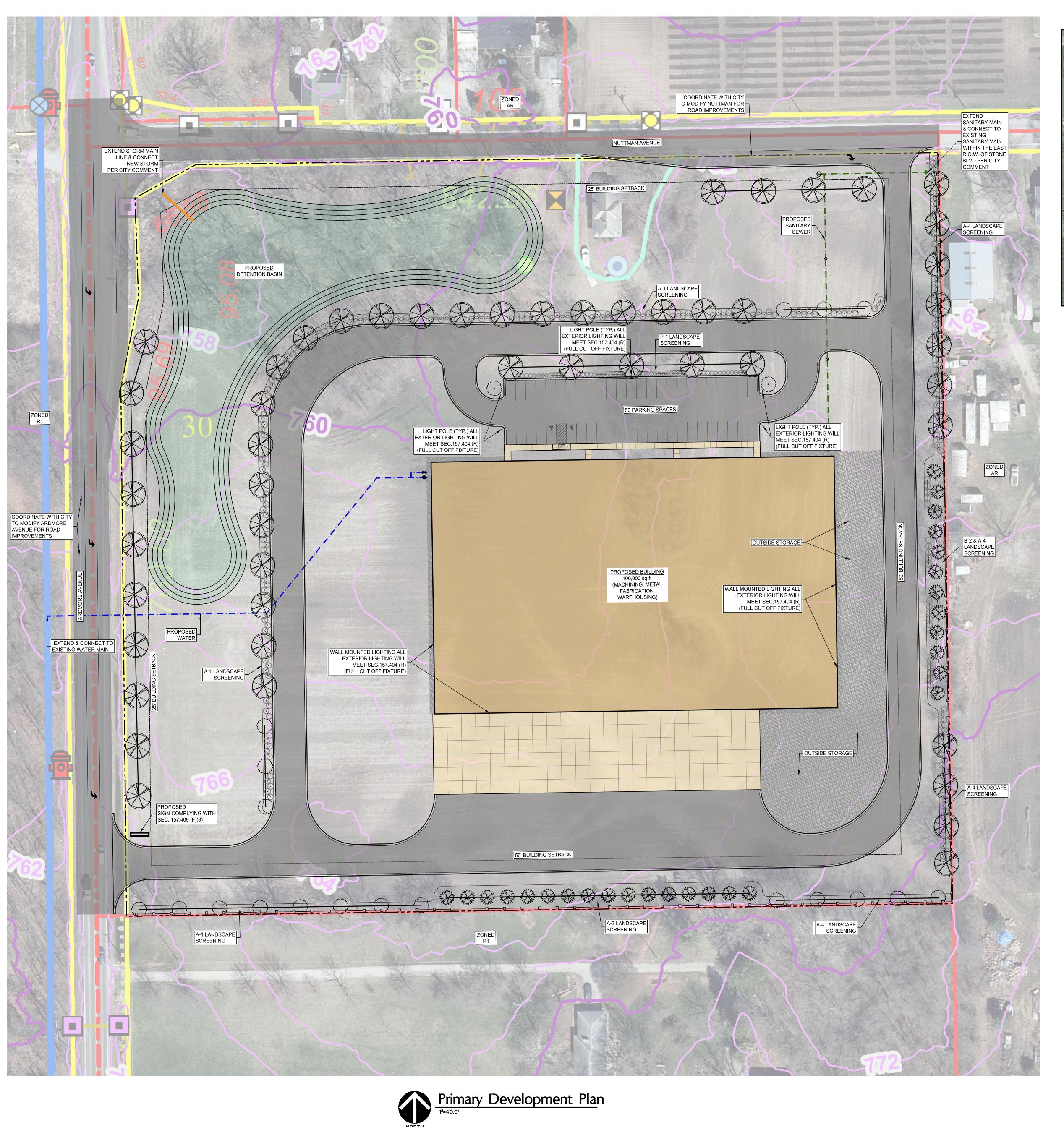

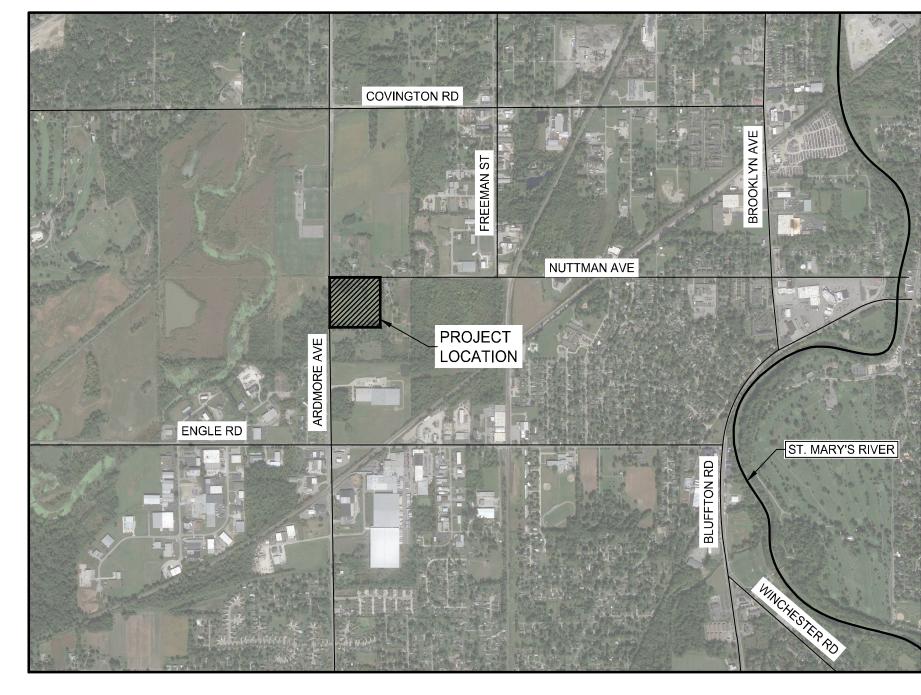
4. The conservation of property values throughout the jurisdiction

5. Responsible development and growth

Responsible development and growth occurs when growth is adjacent to similar uses and is served by existing utility infrastructure, as this site is. Responsible development and growth is shown when it conforms to the Comprehensive Plan, is consistent with current growth patterns, and represents the highest and best use of the property, as described in the responses to the criteria in Items 1 through 4 above.

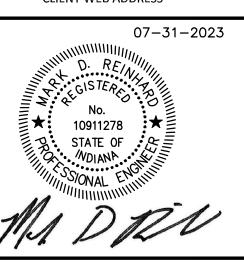
