Subject: 311 Operations Software

Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to authorize the maintenance cost of 311 operations software. The cost of this software to the City is \$164,736.

The City has used Nebulogic for 311 operations since 2016. The software integrates the 311 call center with city departments, like the Utility maintenance departments, Street Department, Street Lighting, Right of Wayne and Utility Developmental Services.

This integration notifies departments of work to be completed and the departmental software notifies the 311 system when the work is completed.

Our decision to pay maintenance rests on four factors:

- Do we have a continuing internal commitment to use this software?
- Is the software vendor continuing to modify the product to meet current needs, laws, and regulations?
- Is the vendor useful in solving problems with the software?
- If the software fails, what's the worst-case scenario?

If the software failed, we would rely on manual procedures to notify departments of the requests for support that come in annually from residents. I recommend continued funding of Nebulogic maintenance.
