Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to authorize the purchase service agreements for our security firewall and VPN software. The total cost of this software is \$149,000. Allen County and Civil City agree to pay 40% of the cost and City Utilities agrees to pay 20% of the cost.

The vendor is ITSavvy LLC, a software reseller recommended by the Indiana Office of Technology. The service agreement for software embedded in our firewall and VPN hardware.

The firewall is the first line of defense between the Internet and our internal systems. The VPN securely extends the reach of our network to remote locations, such as Fire Stations, firetrucks, squad cars, and employees working remotely.

Both firewall and the VPN are integral to the safe and efficient operation of government. I firmly recommend approving this ordinance.
