5 AN ORDINANCE amending the Thoroughfare
6 Plan of the City Comprehensive ("Master")
7 Plan by vacating public right-of-way.

8 WHEREAS, a petition to vacate public right-of-way within the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, (as
9 more specifically described below) was duly filed with the City Clerk of the City of Fort Wayne,
10 Indiana; and

11 WHEREAS, Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, duly held a public hearing
12 and approved said petition, as provided in I.C. 36-7-3-12.

13 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
14 FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

15 SECTION 1. That the petition filed herein to vacate a public right-of-way within the City of
16 Fort Wayne, Indiana, more specifically described as follows, to-wit:

17 An alley located in the Amended Plat of Deer Park Addition to the City of Fort Wayne,
18 recorded in Plat Record 2, Page 17 in the Office of the Recorder of Allen County, Indiana.
19 Said alley is bounded on the North by Lansing Avenue (platted name is Eleanor Avenue) and
20 bounded on the East by the West right-of-way of the Norfolk Southern Railway Company.
21 Surveyed by Nana Opoku, Indiana Professional Surveyor #21200012 and shown on the alley
22 survey exhibit certified on January 16, 2024, as Apex Consulting and Surveying, Inc. Job
23 Number 23020038, and more particularly described as follows:

24 Beginning at a 5/8 inch steel rebar with "OPOKU" identification cap found at the Northwest
25 corner of Lot 13 in said Deer Park Addition; thence South 46 degrees 50 minutes 21 seconds

10 thence North 88 degrees 52 minutes 19 seconds East, a distance of 17.19 feet along said South
11 right-of-way line to the Point of Beginning.

12 and which vacating amends the Thoroughfare Plan of the City Comprehensive ("Master") Plan
13 and is hereby approved in all respects.

14 SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage,
15 any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.

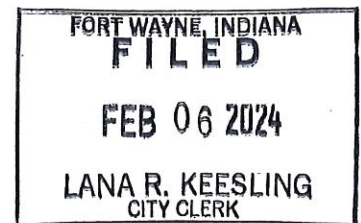

PROJECT SUMMARY

The petitioner, University of Saint Francis, wishes to vacate the unused alley within the plat of Deer Park Addition as shown on the maps. The alley is located northeast of and behind 1300 Leesburg Road. The east end of the alley is adjacent to a Norfolk Southern Railway. The University of Saint Francis owns the land on both sides of the alley. The vacation of the platted alley in the Amended Deer Park Addition will allow for future development of the former alley and the surrounding real estate by University of Saint Francis. The alley has served no purpose in recent history. A review of historical imagery suggests that a commercial building has existed within the alley from prior to the platting of Deer Park Addition through the present. No existing access to other businesses will be affected. Staff has sent requests for comment from all affected utility agencies. When all responses are received, staff will return to Council for discussion.

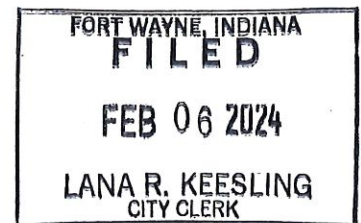

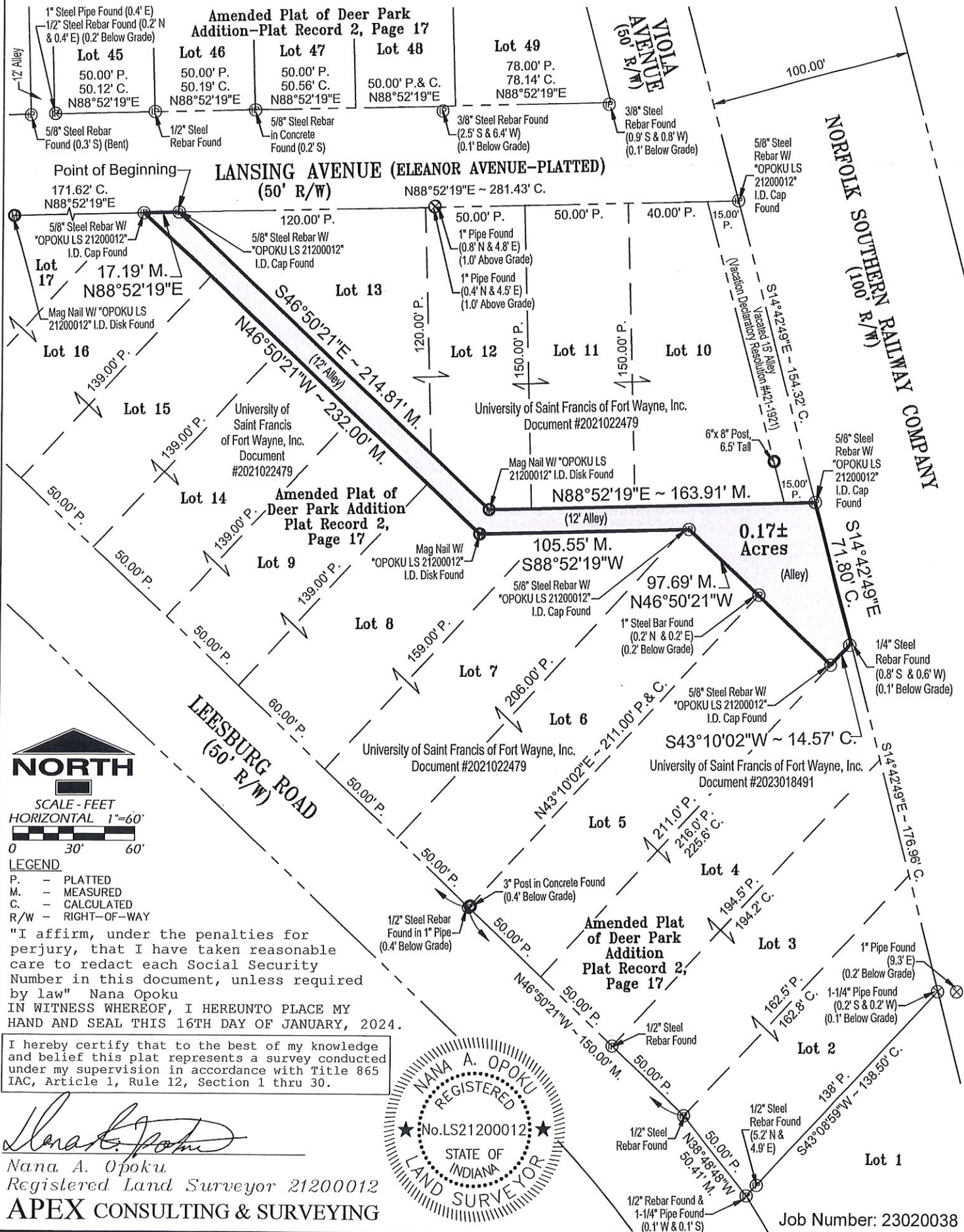

PROJECT SUMMARY

The petitioner, University of Saint Francis, wishes to vacate the unused alley within the plat of Deer Park Addition as shown on the maps. The alley is located northeast of and behind 1300 Leesburg Road. The east end of the alley is adjacent to a Norfolk Southern Railway. The University of Saint Francis owns the land on both sides of the alley. The vacation of the platted alley in the Amended Deer Park Addition will allow for future development of the former alley and the surrounding real estate by University of Saint Francis. The alley has served no purpose in recent history. A review of historical imagery suggests that a commercial building has existed within the alley from prior to the platting of Deer Park Addition through the present. No existing access to other businesses will be affected. Staff has sent requests for comment from all affected utility agencies. All responses have been received, and all have approved, with necessary easement agreements.

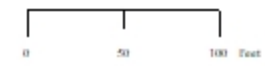

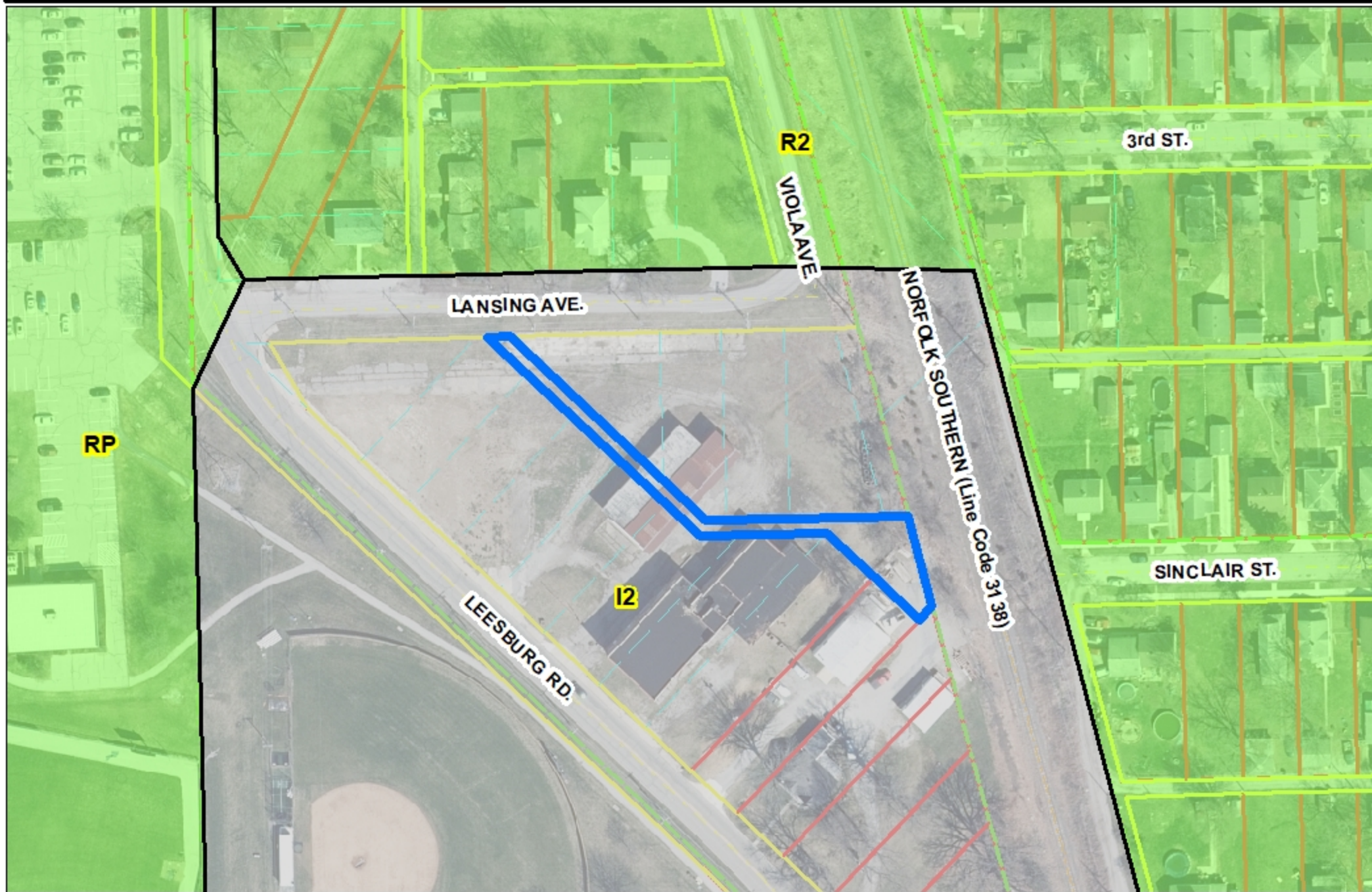
