Subject: Web Hosting Services

Members of City Council:

This ordinance authorizes the purchase of website hosting services. The cost to migrate from the existing website and host a new site is \$167,140.53. In subsequent years the cost of this service will be \$69,140.45 per year.

CivicPlus is used by Allen County for their website and our technical staff is very familiar with its use. Using the same vendor as Allen County will also allow Fort Wayne to provide a similar look, feel, and function as the County site. The selection committee chose CivicPlus for their experience, the look of their sites in other cities and for the technical features they provide, such as:

- Process Automation and Forms
- Payment Gateways
- Search capabilities: accessibility for individuals of all abilities, and a language translation feature to assist non-English speaking visitors to the site.
- Aesthetic Refresh of Site every 4 years

CivicPlus is a national leader in creating accessible web sites. The Department of Justice has issued a final rule requiring cities over 50,000 to comply with their accessibility guidelines by April 24, 2026. These web services will allow us to meet those rules.

Fort Wayne has over 1,500 content pages on our existing website and CivicPlus will assist our departments with the migration of content and training on the use of the system.
