

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA, APPROVING THE DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS FROM THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE COMMUNITY LEGACY FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne has established the City of Fort Wayne Community Legacy Fund ("Legacy Fund") to invest in projects that will have a collective impact that leads to transformational change within the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne and surrounding community members have a long history of investing in small businesses in order to expand capacity and build our economy in such a way that encourages entrepreneurs; and

WHEREAS, Brightpoint has a proven success in running a small business loan programs, having partnered with organizations like the Small Business Association (SBA) and others; and

WHEREAS, there is demand for small business loans within the community and using Legacy funds as seed money for loans allows for the possibility of other groups or organizations participating in this or comparable loan programs, creating greater impact; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has previously created and directed other economic development programs focused on growing businesses in Fort Wayne and this is an extension of those, a separate tool to enhance the Fort Wayne economy; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the forgoing, this funding represents a fraction of the interest income generated by the Corpus; and it is expressly understood that Council affirms the need to preserve the Legacy Corpus, to steward the fund as a trust, and this investment represents the use of the Legacy Fund's anticipated investment income rather than Corpus."

WHEREAS, the Common Council voices support for the Brightpoint Small Business Loan Project ("Project") through the pledge of available funds from the Legacy Fund, as provided in this Resolution.

1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL
2	OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:
3	SECTION 1. The Common Council finds, determines, ratifies and confirms that the
4	Project will have a collective impact that leads to transformational change in the community and
5	is worthy of investment from the Legacy Fund.
6	SECTION 2. The Common Council does hereby confirm and ratify its commitment of
7	Two and One Half Million and No/100 Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) to be used by the Brightpoint to
8	facilitate the Project, with an amount of Five Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$500,000)
9	to be committed annually, no later than September 1 for the years 2024-2028.
10	SECTION 3. The Common Council does hereby authorize the Board of Trustees of the
11	City of Fort Wayne Community Trust Fund to make the distribution set forth in Section 2 above
12	and directs the Community Development Division of the City of Fort Wayne to administer this
13	grant in a timely and appropriate manner.
14	SECTION 4. The passage of this Resolution requires six (6) votes in the affirmative
15	from members of Common Council.
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17	SECTION 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
18	and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.
