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AN ORDINANCE to Approve Change Order #001 to Software Implementation Services Agreement between N. HARRIS COMPUTER CORPORATION (through its Advanced Utility Systems division) and City of Fort Wayne, Indiana.

WHEREAS, the enhancement of the City's cybersecurity infrastructure is essential for the resilience and security of our critical systems;

WHEREAS, adjustments in the project timeline and scope for the Service Link on Version 4 and Customer Information System (CIS) upgrade to Version 5 are necessary due to unforeseen delays in third-party interface readiness as a part of the City of Fort Wayne, Allen County, and City Utilities relocating infrastructure from its existing single on-premises location to two geographically distributed locations: one as the main site, and one as a mirror (duplicate site); and

WHEREAS, the Service Link software, and software interfaces offer greater functionality that will result in gained efficiencies in customer communications management, work management, and billing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Change Order #001, including the extension of the timeline for completion of the project to March 31, 2025 and the Statement of Work for implementation of Service Link needed for the software upgrade and migration to a managed cloud implementation at a total cost of \$171,715.00 is hereby approved in all respects.

SECTION 2. That the City is authorized and directed to take all action necessary for the implementation of the services described in Change Order #001 with N. HARRIS COMPUTER CORPORATION (through its Advanced Utility Systems division).

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.

Background Information

City of Fort Wayne and Advanced Utility Systems (Advanced) entered into a Software Implementation Services Agreement (the Agreement) on January 12, 2024.

As defined in section 1.1 (b) of the Software Implementation Services Agreement: "Change Order" means any written documentation between the Organization and Harris evidencing their agreement to change aspects of this Agreement. Section 4.2 describes a change order: With respect to any proposed changes to the Services defined by this Agreement that do not materially impact the scope of either party's work effort required under this Agreement, the parties will cooperate in good faith to execute Change Orders in respect thereof and will not unreasonably withhold approval of such proposed changes. If either party causes or requests a change that, in the reasonable opinion of the other party, materially impacts the scope of the parties' work effort required under this Agreement, such as, but not limited to, changes in the allocation of the resources of the Organization and of Harris applied to a task, changes in completion schedules for individual tasks or for overall implementation, and changes in staffing that require a party to provide additional work hours, the other party may propose a change to cover the additional work effort required of it. Approval of any such proposed changes will not be unreasonably withheld (it being acknowledged that any such material changes may require modifications to the consideration paid, and timelines governing, the Services), and any disputes regarding changes shall be handled initially by discussions between the parties which will be convened in good faith by the parties to resolve any such matters in dispute.

Based on this provision, Advanced presents the following Change Order to City of Fort Wayne.

Introduction / Purpose

Change Order #001 amends and extends the CIS v5 & Field Workforce Management Project SOW to allow sufficient time and provide ongoing development and testing support during the upgrade from V4 to V5.

Scope

The current project duration of up to 8 months will be extended up to an additional 9 months, and 1 month of post-implementation support – for a project duration total of 18 months – to allow sufficient time for upgrade from v4 to v5.

This extension should provide sufficient time in order to complete items such as City of Fort Wayne development and testing during Phase 5 Interface Delivery and Phase 6 Software Testing, including applicable support from Advanced.


Scope of Work Assumptions

Subject: Utility Customer Billing Software Upgrade and Migration to Cloud

Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to approve Change Order #001 to the Statement of work, Master Services Agreement and license maintenance needed for the software upgrade and migration to a managed cloud implementation at a total cost of \$171,715.00 to be performed by N. HARRIS COMPUTER CORPORATION (through its Advanced Utility Systems division).

City Utilities first purchased this billing and customer communication management system in 2014, which is currently hosted in the City/County/Utility data center out of which we are currently moving.

This software helps meet the needs of the City, and the Utility in the following ways:

- It provides the means by which we track usage and produce billing for all three utilities: water, sewer, and storm.
- It provides the means by which we track usage and produce billing for solid waste.
- It will eliminate our need to replace current aging infrastructure saving approximately \$300,000 every three years, and an additional \$270,000 in current hosting and maintenance costs.
- It will reduce our need for cloud backup, saving approximately \$10,000 per year.
- It will store our data in multiple physical locations, allowing us to recover more quickly from cyber attacks, or physical disasters.
