AN ORDINANCE approving the Purchase and Installation of Yearly Maintenance for Broadband access for Public Safety at a total cost of \$183,600 from and through Verizon Wireless by the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana,

WHEREAS, mobile broadband access is essential to the operation of police services:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the purchase of Broadband access for Public Safety vehicles from Verizon Wireless for a total cost to the City of \$183,600 is hereby approved in all respects. Said yearly fund will be used to ensure the proper operation of communication with the City's police vehicles.

SECTION 2. That the City is authorized and directed to take all action necessary for the purchase of this system by and through Verizon Wireless.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.

Subject: Annual fees for Broadband access for Public Safety vehicles

Members of City Council:

The reason for this purchase is to allow computers in Public Safety vehicles to communicate with 911 dispatch and other public safety vehicles.

This ordinance will authorize the annual purchase of Broadband access for Public Safety from Verizon Wireless for communication with the City's police vehicles. This year's cost of maintenance for telephone software is \$183,600. The Police department intends to equip 510 officers with broadband access in 2023. The actual number will vary as devices go in and out of service.

The effective cost per unit is \$30.01 per month and provides full speeds for up to 5gb of data per month.

The Indiana Office of Technology periodically enters into contracts to provide quantity purchase agreements for units of government in Indiana. The prices for this purchase are from Indiana QPA #09847, amendment 9. The Indiana QPA is based on Federal # GS-35F-0119P.

The prices in this contract are similar to other Indiana Office of Technology contracts with Sprint and AT&T. Due to the substance cost in officer time of switching service providers, I recommend continued use of Verizon Wireless for Broadband access on the City's public safety vehicles.
