Commissioners.

Subject: Geographic Information System cost

Members of City Council:

In 2025 the total cost of GIS is \$890,000. The City of Fort Wayne and Allen County entered an interlocal agreement in 2009 to share the use and costs of a common Geographic Information System equally.

The interlocal covers these items:

- Software maintenance
- Hardware maintenance and replacement
- Aerial Imaging

The Fort Wayne software costs are shared between Civil City and City Utilities. City Utilities pays 2/3 of Fort Wayne's total cost.

Hardware costs are expected to be insignificant in 2025.

Software costs are higher, totaling about \$850,000 in 2025. A three-year software contract ended in 2024.

Aerial imaging costs will be \$40,000 in 2025. Imaging products will be orthophotography, contours, and building outlines.
