### ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- SERVICES. Supplier agrees to perform the Services beginning on the Begin Date and continuing until the Services are completed. Supplier warrants that the Services will be completed on or before the End Date. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE. Supplier warrants that all Services shall conform to the Service Description, be of good quality and weekmanship, and be free from defects. Supplier further warrants that all goods furnished in connection with the Services shall be merchantable and suitably safe and sufficient for the purpose for which they are normally used. Supplier warrants that it has good title to goods supplied becomber and that they are free of all lines and encombances. These warranties are in addition to those implied in fact or in law. For the purposes of this Agreement, the term "Services" shall include any goods furnished in connection with the Services.
- INVOICES. Supplier shall Invoice the City for Services performed according to the Rates, Billing Interval, and Invoice Address. Invoices shall be rendered in triplicate and shall furnite the Service operformed, the Service Address, and the corresponding rates and taxes, If any, Payment shall be within thiny (30) days after the invoice date or the date of completion of the Invoiced Services, whichever within thing (30) days after the invoice date or the date of completion of the invoiced Storices, whichever occurs later, provided that the City shall not be obligated to make any payment to Supplier hecunder until Supplier has furnished proof satisfactory to the City of full payment for all theor, materials, supplies, machinery, and equipment furnished for or used in performance of this Agreement or has furnished all necessary walves of lien supported by antidaxins, all satisfactory to the City, establishing that all liens and rights to claim liens that could wribe out of the performance of the Services have been walved. Payment of Invoices shall not constitute acceptance of the Services, and Invoices shall be subject to adjustment for defects in quality or any other failure of Supplier to meet the requirements of this Agreement. The City may at any time set off any amount oxed by the City to supplier against any amount oxed by Supplier or any of its affiliated companies to the City.
- INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR RELATIONSHIP. City and Supplier are and shill remain as independent contractors with respect to each editer. The persons provided by Supplier to perform the Services shall be Supplier's employees and shall be under the sole and exclusive direction and coatted of Supplier. They shall not be considered employees of the City for any purpose. Supplier shall be responsible for compliance with all laws, rules and regulations involving, but not limited to, employment of labor, hours of labor, health and safety, working conditions, and payment of wages with respect to such persons. Supplier shall also be responsible for payment of taxes, including federal, sate and raunicipal taxes chargeable or assessed with respect to its employees, such as Social Security, unramployment, Workers' Compensation, disability Insurance, and federal and state withholding supplier shall also be responsible for providing such reasonable accommodations, including suvillary aids and services, as may be required under the Americans With Disabilities Act, 42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq., to as to enable any disabled person furnished by Supplier to perform the essential functions of the job. Supplier agrees to defend, indemnify, and held hamiless the City from and against any loss, cost, clain, liability, damage, or expense (including atterney's fees) that may be sustained by reason of Supplier's failure to comply with this paragraph.
- INDEMITY. Supplier shall defend, Indennify, and held huntless the City (including Its officers, employees, and agont) from all demands, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees), Judgments, settlements, and penalties of every kind ariting out of its performance of Services including, without limitation, damages for personal linguage or death or loss or damage to property due, or claimed to be due, to the negligence or willful inisconduct of Supplier including such pertion thereof due, or claimed to be due, to the negligence of the City except that Supplier shall have no duly to led harmless the City for such pertion of the foregoing proximately caused by negligence or misconduct of the City, and If any sult, claim, or demand was defended by Supplier, then the City will reliabures Supplier for its pro-rata share of its costs, expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees), and damages. The City may elect to priticipate in the defense of any sult, claim, or demand by employing attorneys. Its own expense, without waiving Supplier's colliquitions to Indemnify, defend, or held harmless. Supplier shall not sentle or componite any claim, sult, or action, or consent to ontry of Judgment without the prior written consent of the City and without an unconditional release of all liability by each claimant or plaintiff to the City.
- LIMITATION OF LIABILITY. Each party's liability to the other for any loss, cost, claim, liability, damage, or expense (including atterneys' fees) relating to or arising out of any negligent act or omission in its performance of obligations arising out of this Agreement, shall be limited to the amount of direct damage actually incurred. Absent gross negligence or knowing and willful misconduct which causes a loss, neither party shall be liable to the other for any indirect, special or consequential damage of any kind whateverer.

- HAZARDOUS MATERIALS. Supplier will provide to the City before performing any Services, a statement describing any Hazardous Materials intended and necessary for use in performing the Services. "Hazardous Materials" means any litem which may be classified under federal, state, or local law, as hazardous or tools. Supplier must comply with all federal, state, or local law in the use, usunspectation, and disposal of such Hazardous Materials.
- PROGRESS REPORTS. The Supplier shall submit progress reports to the City upon request. The report shall serve the purpose of assuring the City that work is progressing in line with the schedule, and that completion can be reasonably assured on the scheduled date. This contract shall be deemed to the substantially performed only when fully performed according to its terms and conditions and any medification thereof.
- CONFLICT OF INTEREST. Supplier certifies and warrants that neither it nor any of its directors, officers, agents, representatives or employees which will participate in any way in the performance of the Supplier's obligations hereunder has or will have any conflict of interest, direct or Indirect, with the City of Fort Wayne or any of its department, divisions, agencies, officers, directors or agents.

- CONFIDENTIALITY OF DATA PROPERTY RIGHTS IN PRODUCTS, AND COPYRIGHT CONFIDENTIALITY OF DATA. PROPERTY RIGHTS IN PRODUCTS, AND COPYRIGHT PROHIBITION. Supplier further suggests that all information, data findings, recommendations, proposals, etc. by whatever name described and by whatever form therein secured, developed, written or produced by the Supplier in furtherance of this contract—shall be the property of the City. The Supplier shall take action as is necessary under law to preserve such property rights in and of the City while such property is within the control and/or custedy of the Supplier. By this contract the Supplier specifically waives and/or releases to the City any cognizable property right of the Supplier to copyright, license, patent or other wise use such information, data findings, recommendations proposals, etc.
- CONFIDENTIALITY OF CITY INFORMATION. Supplier understands and agrees that data, materials, and information disclosed to Supplier may contain confidential and protected data. Therefore, the Supplier promises and assures that data, material, and information gathered, based upon or disclosed to the Supplier for the purpose of this contract, will not be disclosed to others or discussed with other parties without the prior written consent of the City.
- EMPLOYER CERTIFICATION. In accordance with LC.\$22-5-1.7, Supplier understands and agrees to enroll and verify work eligibility status of all newly-bleed employees of the contractor through E-Verify program or any other system of legal residence verification as approved by the United States Department of Honeland Security or the department of Honeland security. Supplier further understands that they are not required to verify work eligibility of status of newly-bleed employees of the Supplier through the E-Verify program in the E employ any unsutherized aliens.
- COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS. Supplier warrants that the Services shall be in strict conformity with all applicable local, state and federal laws including, but not limited to, the standards promulgated by the occupational Safety and Health Act, Executive Order 11246, as amended, relative to Equal Employment Opportunity and ell other applicable laws, rules, and regulations, including the Civil Rights Act of 1984 pertaining to equal epoperhority, Section 500 of the Vectalocal Rehabilitation Act of 1971, the American with Disabilities Act, Section 402 of the Victaum Era Veterans Readjustment Assistance Act of 1974 and all applicable lamingration laws and regulations including the 1936 Immigration Reform and Control Act et. see, Supplier agrees to indemnify and held barmless the City from and against any loss, cost, claim, liability, damage, or expense (including atterney's fees) that may be sustained because of Supplier's breach of such warranty.
- DEFAULT. In the event that (a) Supplier breaches any warranty contained herein; (b) Supplier fails to provide the insurance certificate required herein; (c) Supplier or Supplier's Insurance carrier fails to defend, Indonnilly, or hold hamdess the City as required herein; (d) Supplier's performance of the Services violates applicable law; (e) Supplier admits insolvency, makes an assignment for the benefit creditors, or has a functee appointed totake over all or a substantial part of its assict; or (f) Supplier fails to perform or comply with any other provision of this Agreement, such failure, breach, or violation shall constitute a default under this Agreement.
- TERMINATION. In the event of default by Supplier under this Agreement, the City reserves the right without liability, in addition to its other rights and remedies, to terminate this Agreement by notice to Supplier as to the portion of the Services not yet rendered and to purchase substitute services at Supplier's expense. Supplier shall reimburse the City for the cost of such substitute services upon Supplier's receipt of an invoice therefore.
- WAIVER. No action or inaction by the City shall constitute a waiver of any right or remedy.
- CANCELLATION. City may at any time cancel this Agreement in whole or in part for its sole convenience upon written notice to Supplier, and Supplier shall stop performing the Services on the date specified in such notice. The City shall have no liability as a result of such cancellation, except that the City will pay Supplier the Rates for completed Services accepted by the City and the actual incurred cost to Supplier for Services in progress. These payments shall not exceed the Aggregate Price.
- FORCE MAJEURE. Neither party shall be liable to the other or responsible for nonperformance of any of the terms of this Agreement due to unforceseable causes beyond the reasonable control and without the fault or negligence of such party, including, but not restricted to acts of God or the public enemy, acts of government, fire, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, freight embargoes, or unusually extendible to the public enemy.

This ordinance is to upgrade the remaining remote stations located throughout the sewer distribution system. Replacing the remaining SD-9 obsolete radios with the standardized Orbit platform radios. City Utilities has standardized both water/sewer plants SCADA radio communications with the Orbit hardware/software manufactured by GE Vernova for which J&K Communications is the sole source provider in our service area. This service agreement is for J&K Communications in the not to exceed amount of \$137,727.00.

#### Implications of not being approved:

City Utilities selection provides standardization through compatibility of SCADA radio communications among the utility's multiple locations of water/sewer/storm remote stations. The standardization also allows for single maintenance and management of all sites and locations. Additions and improvements to the system will be compatible with both hardware and software. Upgrades are required due to aging/obsolete equipment that is used to notify plant personnel of potential problems so they can begin to address issues before resulting in basement backups or sanitary overflows due to power and/or equipment failure.
