REQUIREMENTS TO PROVIDE LABOR FOR REPAIRS TO FORT WAYNE UTILITY SYSTEMS CUTS AROUND INFRASTRUCTURE

Scope of Work:

Fort Wayne Utilities is requesting time and material quotes for contracting various types of labor for repairs to Concrete Cuts made by the Utilities in the repair of the distribution and collection systems. Such repairs may include but shall not be limited to: excavating cold patch and fill, framing, pouring, finishing concrete to proper grades and elevations per City specifications, to bring the repair back to specification and proper level with minimal level differential to cause issues. All repairs are to be made in accordance with the City of Fort Wayne Construction Standard Details and Specifications found at https://www.cityoffortwayne.org/engineers-contractors/standard-specifications.html.

It is the intent of the Utility, for purposes of emergencies and to complete restoration in a timely manner after utility repairs are completed, to have a list of contact names, emergency numbers, and equipment required to complete assigned work.

Term of agreement: January 1, 2025 through March 1, 2026 on an "as needed" basis. This quote does not guarantee work within the above time frame.

Contractor Responsibilities:

For all sites, the contractor shall be required to contact IUPPS with the pertinent information regarding the proposed work.

The contractor shall furnish experienced and competent supervision for program participants having sufficient knowledge of Fort Wayne Utility Standards and Specifications and Public Works Construction Standards and Specifications.

The contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, its officers and employees, from all damages, claims, suits, and actions of any descriptions for, or resulting from, injuries or damages received or sustained by any party or parties arising out of any act or failure to act, of said contractor, or his agents, in the execution of work under the contract.

The contractor shall be responsible for adherence to all OSHA regulations for trenching and shoring. In addition, contractor shall notify City for when traffic control, signage, barricades, etc. are needed in order to complete a project.

Repair Materials:

Spoil from the cut shall be disposed of at the Biosolids Facility on Lake Avenue for materials that were removed from cuts that occurred after normal working hours. If access is not established to these sites, then spoils can be dumped at the Maintenance Department yards if authorized by Utility personnel.

Statements of Conditions

Payment will be based on the quote received by the Board of Works. The designated work site shall be specified by the Utility. Payment is subject to an inspection of the work that has been completed. Payments will be made to the contractor within forty-five (45) days following receipt of invoices. Invoices are to be mailed directly to Chris Brown at 415 E. Wallace St., Fort Wayne, IN 46802.

Contractor shall have 60 days to complete each assignment, unless otherwise stated in a written schedule approved and accepted by the Utility Supervisor. Work not completed within this timeframe may result in a delay of payment.

This agreement may be terminated in part or in whole, if any work performed is not in accordance with the standards established by the Utility. Work may not be accepted or paid for by the Utility if not in accordance with the standards and specifications outlined in this agreement. Any re-work due to Contractor error or negligence to bring Work into compliance with this agreement shall be at the contractor's expense.

Fort Wayne Construction Trades proposes the following items for the repair and restoration work that the City Water Maintenance is requesting. With the partnership of employment of Fort Wayne Community Schools. Fort Wayne Construction Trades students will begin restoration work as soon as the ground thaws or upon special request, and will continue working until or through December 2025. A crew will begin the work under general instructional supervision of Chris Roberts and site supervision of Lucas Madden. There will be a group of eight High School Junior's hired and three college enrolled alumni re-hired site supervisors from the Career Academy Construction Trades, All students will be subject to the general hiring guidelines and employment regulations of Fort Wayne Community Schools. The restoration stuff will be held to all safety guidelines specified by The City Fort Wayne Water Maintenance. The general hourly pay rate of the entire crew of eight students, one dirt crew foreman, one concrete foreman, one daily operations supervisor, and one general instructor is \$350.00. During the 2025 school year the staff will be supervised indirectly by Chris Roberts as an unpaid position. At the conclusion of the 2025 school year the instructor will join the team of construction trades students on site. This pay scale is subject to change due to weekly crew changes and personnel daily schedules but will not exceed the \$350.00 per hour rate. The amount per hour will only exceed the rate listed above due to overtime pay on a bi-weekly basis. at a rate of time and a half for each employee.

All materials necessary for job completion will be charged to City Water Maintenance over and beyond the general hourly rate. The items included as part of material fees would include concrete, rebar, expansion, curing, form release, gasoline, hand tools, concrete forms and minor equipment repairs. All receipts and invoices will be submitted to City Water Maintenance for their records.
