**A RESOLUTION APPROVING PROJECTS AND  
FUNDING FROM INTEREST EARNED FROM THE FORT  
WAYNE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA)  
APPROVED PLAN FUNDING**

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Congress enacted the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021("ARPA") on March 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, ARPA provides emergency funding to state and local governments to support their recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana has been allocated \$50,815,327.00 from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (under "ARPA"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne adopted Special Ordinance on S-58-21 on May 11, 2021, which established the purpose, permitted uses and minimum percentages per category of the ARPA fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne adopted Resolution R-22-03-22 on April 12, 2022, approving the City of Fort Wayne Recovery Plan, State & Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Wayne obligated its ARPA grant funds by the end of 2024, as required, and will spend the obligated grant funds by the end of 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Wayne desires the Common Council to approve the project and funding requested from ARPA **interest earned funds**:

Youth Violence Prevention Program \$250,000

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:**

**SECTION 1.** The Common Council approves the above project and the funding from the ARPA interest earned funds.
