AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 38: CITY POLICIES OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE CODE OF ORDINANCES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That CHAPTER 38: CITY POLICIES of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, Code of Ordinances of be amended as follows:

# **ADD NEW SECTIONS AS FOLLOWS:**

# §38.07 TITLE.

This article may be cited and referred to as the "Non-Disclosure of Public Records for Commercial Purpose Ordinance".

# §38.08 POLICY.

It is hereby declared to be the public policy of the City:

- (A) That the City recognizes that under the Access to Public Records Act, I.C. 5-14-3-1, et. seq. (the "APRA") providing persons with information is an essential function of a representative government and an integral part of the routine duties of public officials and employees, whose duty it is to provide the information.
- (B) The City also recognizes that its resources are limited and the APRA gives discretion to the City to determine in certain cases the limits to the type of information that may be disclosed and specifically permits, pursuant to I.C.4-22-2, the City to create an ordinance limiting the disclosure of information to persons who seek information for commercial purpose.

## §38.09 DEFINITIONS.

For the purpose of this subchapter the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning:

CITY. The City of Fort Wayne, its Departments and Divisions.

**COMMERCIAL PURPOSE**. Selling, advertising, or soliciting the purchase of merchandise, goods, or services or selling, loaning, giving away, or otherwise delivering the information obtained to any other person for these purposes.

1	PUBLIC RECORDS. Any writing, paper, report, study, map, photograph, book, card, tape recording, or other material that is created, received, retained, maintained, or filed		
2	by or with the CITY and which is generated on paper, paper substitutes, photographic		
3	media, chemically based media, magnetic or machine readable media, electronically stored data, or any other material, regardless of form or characteristics.		
4	§38.10 NON-DISCLOSURE OF PUBLIC RECORDS FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSE		
5	The City, in its discretion, may decline a request for public records under the APRA to the extent such request is sought by or on behalf of a person or entity who will or may		
6	use those records for commercial purpose. The determination of whether a requestor is seeking public records for commercial purpose shall be made by the City.

8	SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is in full force and effect from and after		
9	its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.
