All labor, insurance, material, equipment, tools, power, transportation, miscellaneous equipment, etc., necessary for WORK THAT MAY INCLUDE BUT SHALL NOT BE LIMITED TO: PRUNING BRANCHES, CUTTING DOWN TREES AND SHRUBS, STUMP GRINDING, ROOT CHASING, AND **CUTTING** DOWN HERBACEOUS MATERIAL. VEGETATION THAT IS CUT DOWN OR GROUND DOWN SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE SITE PROMPTLY AFTER WORK IS COMPLETED. THIS WORK MAY BE PERFORMED IN RELATION TO OTHER CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS, WHICH SHALL REQUIRE COORDINATION OF WORK BETWEEN SAID CONTRACTORS. WHEN DIRECTED, STUMPS AND ROOTS SHALL BE GROUND AT LEAST 8 INCHES BELOW GROUND LEVEL AND 6 INCHES BEYOND THE WORK AREA TO ALLOW FOR PROPER CONCRETE SETUP AND POURING. THE WORK MAY ENTAIL PRE-COORDINATED LOCATIONS FOR TREE REMOVAL AND STUMP GRINDING, AND EMERGENCY REQUESTS THAT REQUIRE A 48-HOUR RESPONSE TIME;

- SERVICES. Supplier agrees to perform the Services beginning on the Begin Date and continuing until the Services are completed. Supplier warronts that the Services will be completed on or before the End the Services are completed. Supplier warrants that the Services will be completed on or before the End Date. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE. Supplier warrants that all Services shall conform to the Service Description, be of good quality and workmanship, and be free from defects. Supplier furnitier warrants that all goods furnished in connection with the Services shall be merchantable and suitably safe and sufficient for the purpose for which they are normally used. Supplier warrants that it has good into goods supplied hereunder and that they are free of all liens and encumbrances. These warranties are in addition to those implied in fact or in law. For the purposes of this Agreement, the term "Services" shall include any goods furnished in connection with the Services.
- INVOICES. Supplier shall invoice the City for Services performed according to the Rates, Billing Interval, and Invoice Address. Invoices shall be rendered in triplicate and shall itemize the Services performed, the Service Address, and the corresponding rates and taxes, if any. Payment shall be due within thirty (30) days after the invoice date or the date of completion of the invoiced Services, whichever occurs later, provided that the City shall not be obligated to make any payment to Supplier hereunder until Supplier has furnished proof satisfactory to the City of full payment for all labor, materials, supplies, machinery, and equipment furnished for or used in performance of this Agreement or has furnished all lices are the city to the City of the City of the City catabilish has that all lices. machinery, and equipment transact of to execut performance of the Services and of his humaned increasing waivers of lien supported by affidavits, all satisfactory to the City, establishing that all liens and rights to claim liens that could prise out of the performance of the Services have been waived. Payment of invoices shall not constitute acceptance of the Services, and invoices shall be subject adjustment for defects in quality or any other failure of Supplier to meet the requirements of this Agreement. The City may all any time set off any amount owed by the City to supplier against any smount owed by Supplier or any of its affiliated companies to the City.
- INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR RELATIONSHIP. The relationship between City and Supplier is and shall at all times remain as independent contractors. Persons provided by Supplier to perform and deliver shall at all lines remain as independent contractors. Persons provided by Supplier to perform and deliver the Services shall be Supplier's employees under the sole and exclusive direction and control of Supplier and shall not be considered employees of City for any purpose. Supplier eshall be responsible for compliance by Supplier's employees and any other person or entity contracted or permitted by Supplier to perform and deliver the Services, with all laws, rules and regulations applicable to the performance and delivery of the Services hereunder, including but not limited to employment, labor, wage and bour, health and safety, and working conditions. Supplier shall be responsible for the payment of all federal, state and local taxes and charges of any type or nature assessed with respect to Supplier's employees and any other persons or entities contracted or permitted by Supplier to provide and deliver the Services, including Social Security, unemployment, Workmen's Compensation, disability insurance and federal and state withholding. Supplier shall be responsible for providing such reasonable accommodations which may be required under the Americans with Disabilities Act, 42 U.S.C.12101 et seq. in order that any person with disabilities employed, contracted or permitted by Supplier to provide the Services to be able to perform the essential functions of such person's job-related duties. Supplier agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless City, to the extent permitted by low, from ond against any loss, cost, claim, liability, damage or expense (including attorneys' fees) that may be asserted against or incurred by City as a result of Supplier's failure to comply with the covenants and obligations of this paragraph.
- INDEMINITY. Supplier shall defend, indemnify and hold hombess City, its officers, directors, cappoyees, representatives, agents, departments and divisions, to the extent permitted by law, from and against all demands, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees), judgments, settlements and penalties of every kind and nature asserted against, charged to or imposed. upon City which directly or indirectly prise or ore associated with the performance and delivery of Services by Supplier, the employees of Supplier or any person or entity contracted or permitted by Supplier to provide and deliver the Services, which is claimed to be caused directly or indirectly to the negligent or Intentional act or omission of Supplier, any employee of Supplier or any person or entity contracted or permitted by Supplier to perform and deliver the Services, including, without limitation, contracted or permitted by Supplier to perform and deliver the Survices, including, without limitation, damages for property. Cily may elect to particular in the defense of any lawsuit, claim or demand in which City is a named party or in which City may have an interest by employing attorneys selected by City at City's expense or to be represented by Supplier's counsel at Supplier's expense, without waiving Supplier's defense, Indemnity and Indef harmless obligations to City contained herein. Supplier shall not settle or compromise any claim, suit or action or consent of City or a judgment without the prior written consent of City and without the unconditional release of City from liability by each claimant or plaintiff. The indemnification covenants contained herein shall survive the completion of the performance and delivery of the Services.
- LIMITATION OF LIABILITY. Supplier's liability hereunder for any loss, cost, claim liability, damage or expense (including attorneys' fees) priving out of any negligent or intentional act or omission of the performance of the obligations hereunder by Supplier, Supplier's employees or any person or entity contracted or permitted by Supplier to perform any obligation under this Agreement shall be limited to the amount of the direct damage incurred by City. Abtent grossly negligent or willful misconduct by Supplier, Supplier's employees or ony person or entity contracted or permitted by Supplier to perform the obligations under this Agreement, Supplier shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, special, consequential or punitive damages of any kind whatsoever.
- INSURANCE. Supplier shall maintain in full force and effect during the performance and delivery of the Services, and shall require any person or entity contracted or permitted by Supplier to perform and deliver the Services, the following insurance coverage:

- HAZARDOUS MATERIALS. Supplies will provide to the City before performing any Services, a statement describing any Hazardous Materials intended and necessary for use in performing the Services. "Hazardous Materials" means any liem which may be clossified under federal, state, or local law, as hazardous or toxio. Supplier must comply with all federal, state, or local law in the use, transportation, and disposal of such Hazardous Materials.
- PROGRESS REPORTS. The Supplier shall submit progress reports to the City upon request. The report shall serve the purpose of assuring the City that work is progressing in line with the schedule, and that completion can be reasonably assured on the scheduled date. This contract shall be deemed to the substantially performed only when fully performed according to its terms and conditions and any outliers to the other than the schedule. modification thereof.
- CONFLICT OF INTEREST. Supplier certifies and warrants that neither it nor any of its directors, officers, agents, representatives, board members, or employees which will participate in any way in the performance of the Supplier's obligations hereunder has or will have ony conflict of interest, direct or indirect, with the City of Fort Wayne or any of its departments, divisions, agencies, officers, directors, board members, or agents.
- CONFIDENTIALITY OF DATA, PROPERTY RIGHTS IN PRODUCTS, AND COPYRIGHT PROHIBITION. Supplier further agrees that all information, data findings, recommendations, proposals, etc. by whatever name described and by whatever form therein secured, developed, written or produced by the Supplier in furtheronce of this contract—shall be the property of the City. The Supplier shall take action as is necessary under law to preserve such property rights in and of the City while such property is within the control and/or custody of the Supplier. By this contract the Supplier specifically waives only releases to the City any cognizable property right of the Supplier to copyright, thense, patent or other wise use such information, data findings, recommendations proposals, etc.
- CONFIDENTIALITY OF CITY INFORMATION. Supplier understands and agrees that data, materials, and information disclosed to Supplier may contain confidential and protected data. Therefore, the Supplier promises and assures that data, material, and information gathered, based upon or disclosed to the Supplier for the purpose of this contract, will not be disclosed to others or discussed with other parties without the prior written consent of the City.
- EMPLOYER CERTIFICATION. In accordance with I.C. §22-5-1.7, Supplier understands and agrees to enroll and verify work eligibility status of all newly hired employees of the contractor through R-Verify program or any other system of legal residence verification as approved by the United States Department of Homeland Security or the department of homeland security. Supplier further understands that they are not required to verify work eligibility of status of newly hired employees of the Supplier through the E-Verity program if the E-Verity program no longer exists. Supplier certifies that they do not knowingly employ any unauthorized allens.
- COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS. Supplier shall relimburs the City for the cost of such substitute services upon Supplier's receipt of an invoice, therefore
- WAIVER. No action or inaction by the City shall constitute a waiver of eny right or remedy.
- CANCELLATION. City may at any lime ceased this Agreement in whole or in part for its solo convenience upon written notice to Suppiler, and Suppiler shall stop performing the Services on the date specified in such notice. The City shall have no liability as a result of such cancellation, except that the City will pay Suppiler the Rotes for completed Services accepted by the City and the actual incurred cost to Supplier for Services in progress. These payments shall not exceed the Aggregate Price.
- FORCE MAJEURE. In the event of any dispute or disagreement between the parties either with respect to the interpretation of any provision of this ogreement, or with respect to the performance of either party hereunder, the dispute shall be resolved by the Director of Finance and Administration and will not be subject to arbitration.
- ACCESS TO RECORDS. The Supplier shall maintain all books, documents, papers, accounting records, and other evidence pertaining to the cost incurred. They shall make such materials available at their respective offices at all reasonable times during the contract period and for three (3) years from the date of final payment under the contract for inspection by the City or by any other authorized representative of city government. Copies thereof shall be furnished at no cost to the City if requested,

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state of Indiana and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts therein. This Agreement embodies the entire agreement between the patties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior agreements and understanding, whether written or oral, and all contemporaneous and agreements and understandings relating to the subject matter hereof. No agreement hereafter made shall be effective to modify or discharge this Agreement, in whole or in part, unless such agreement is in writing and signed by the party against whom enforcement of the modification or discharge is sought. The paragraph headings are for convenience only and are not intended to affect the interpretation of the provisions hereof. This agreement shall be binding on the parties hereto and their respective personal and legal representatives, successors and assigns.

2025 Tree Removal Package B

Action Requested:

Requesting an Ordinance approving the **2025 Tree Removal Package B** project pursuant to the Board of Public Works Resolution #**1003P** and an award to **Worx Companies** in an amount **not to exceed \$250,000.00**.

Note: This is an On Call Service Agreement.

Description and Scope of the Work:

The work may include but shall not be limited to: pruning branches, cutting down trees and shrubs, stump grinding, root chasing, and cutting down herbaceous material. Any vegetation that is cut down or ground down shall be removed from the site promptly after work is completed. This work may be performed in relation to other construction projects, which shall require coordination of work between said contractors. When directed, stumps and roots shall be ground at least 8 inches below ground level and 6 inches beyond the work area to allow for proper concrete setup and pouring. The work may entail pre-coordinated locations for tree removal and stump grinding, and emergency requests that require a 48-hour response time.
