RE: Selking International non-OEM parts purchases.

The City of Fort Wayne Fleet Department is seeking approval to increase its purchase order with Selking International by \$55,000. This increase is to cover the following:

- 1. Increased parts purchased due to the number of heavy trucks the city owns.
- 2. Increased cost of parts due to inflation and tariffs.
- 3. Since moving the Fleet repair facility to its new location, we can now internalize more repair work due to increased space and facility upgrades.
- 4. Increased maintenance costs, as our fleet ages the expectation is we will incur more repair costs, by internalizing these repairs we reduce the outside labor costs but increase our parts purchases.
- 5. Selking is currently our biggest non-oem part supplier due to them offering us a lower parts price for our non-oem parts needs.
- 6. Fleet is not asking for additional funding; we are only requesting the P.O. amount be increased. We have additional money for this increase already in our budget for this year.

In 2025, Fleet Management continued to expand our efforts to internalize repairs, making significant progress toward our goal of reducing costs. This year has presented challenges related to increased parts costs due to tariffs and supply chain issues. To help offset these expenses, Fleet has focused on refurbishing and rebuilding parts whenever possible, rather than relying on replacements. Our ongoing objective is to internalize all non-warranty repairs, achieving this will allow us to better utilize our skilled staff, improve turnaround times for departments, and ultimately enhance our ability to serve the residents of Fort Wayne.
