Subject: Annual fees for Broadband access for Public Safety vehicles

Members of City Council:

The reason for this purchase is to allow computers in Public Safety vehicles to communicate with 911 dispatch and other public safety vehicles.

This ordinance will authorize the annual purchase of broadband access for Public Safety from Verizon Wireless for communication with the City's police vehicles. This year's cost of maintenance for data service is \$188,500. The police department intends to equip 515 officers with broadband access in 2026. The actual number will vary as devices go in and out of service.

The effective cost per unit is \$30.50 per month and provides full speeds for unlimited data per month.

The Indiana Office of Technology periodically enters into contracts to provide quantity purchase agreements for units of government in Indiana. The prices for this purchase are from Indiana BPA #71748.

The prices in this contract are similar to other Indiana Office of Technology contracts with T-Mobile and AT&T. Due to the substantial cost in officer time of switching service providers I recommend continuing to use of Verizon Wireless for broadband access on the City's public safety vehicles.
